- 8:00- 2:00: Grades 11 and 12

Friday September 3rd:

- 8:00- 2:00: Grade 10 induction and personal project workshop
- 7:25- 3:20: Grade 12 (Regular classes)

Monday September 6th:

- 7:25- 3:20 (Full Day): Grades 6,9, 11 and 12

Tuesday September 7th:

Everyone in: Grades 6-12 all students and staff in face to face classes observing COVID protocol.

*Buses will start running on Monday September 6th.

All information regarding a safe return to school will be shared during the orientation.

The orientation sessions will be recorded and shared on our website.

COVID Guidelines

Every student should

- Come in wearing a mask and be cleared by the security officer at the gate.
- Understand that he/she will be asked to go home if he/she is found to have a temperature of 37.5 degrees or above.
- Keep his/her mask on at all times and respect the school's social distancing rules.
- Have a water bottle and a snack.
- Have all required material (pen, pencil, ruler, Calculator, laptop, books, copybooks). Students cannot borrow anything from a friend.
- Have an extra-mask in a clean plastic bag.
- Have his/her own sanitizer.

Other guidelines

- The school gate opens at 7:00 AM
- Students need to wear their uniform
- Students should have a bag to put their books/resources
- Mobile phones are not allowed
- Students need to leave promptly after their session is over
